## Win a school trip to St. George's Park: Prize Draw Terms and Conditions

- 1. The promoter of the Prize Draw is The Football Association Limited ("**The FA**"), Wembley Stadium, Wembley, London HA9 0WS.
- 2. Entry into the Prize Draw is dependent on your acceptance of these terms and conditions and by entering the Prize Draw you confirm your acceptance of these terms and conditions.
- 3. Entrants must be based in the United Kingdom. Employees of The FA, any FA Group Company or anyone professionally connected to this Prize Draw and members of their immediate families are not permitted to enter the Prize Draw.
- 4. To enter the Prize Draw you must complete the schools booking process to attend England v Slovenia. Entries will be selected at random to win.

- 8. The Winner and Runners-Up will be randomly selected by an adjudicator appointed by The FA, from all the entry submissions received by the Closing Date in respect of this Competition. The adjudicator's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 9. All entrants into the Prize Draw agree, by entering the Prize Draw, that The FA may use any aspect of their entry for any reason (including but not limited to publicity and promotional purposes). Entrants automatically assign all rights in any entry to The FA. All entrants into the Prize Draw waive any moral rights they may have in relation to their entry.
- 10. There is a maximum of one entry per person.
- 11. The FA does not accept responsibility for any entries which are lost, delayed, incomplete or otherwise not received or cannot be entered for technical or any other reason. Proof of delivery of the entry is not proof of receipt. Incomplete or illegible entries or those not in accordance with the entry instructions and these terms and conditions are invalid.
- 12. All prizes are non-exchangeable, non-transferable, and not redeemable for cash or other prizes (in whole or in part). In the event of unforeseen circumstances or circumstances outside The FA's control, The FA reserves the right to offer an alternative prize of equal or greater value. Travel and accommodation are not included in any of the prizes and The FA accepts no responsibility for any costs associated with any prize which are not specifically included in that prize, including, without limitation, meals and drinks, personal expenses, insurance and travel expenses in connection with the prize. Winners are strictly prohibited from selling their prizes to any other person.
- 13. The Prize Draw winners will be notified on or before 3pm on Thursday 14 September 2017.
- 14. The Winner and Runners-Up must respond and confirm acceptance to The FA within 48 hours of being notified of the outcome in order to claim a prize. If the Winner or Runners-Up do not confirm acceptance within that time period, another winner or

- runner-up may be selected from the other eligible entries received before the Closing Date.
- 15. The FA has the right to select an alternative winner or substitute winner which shall be the next participant that is selected at random from the remaining eligible entries if: (i) a winner is ineligible to enter the Prize Draw; (ii) The FA is unable to reach a winner within the timeframe outlined above; or (iii) a winner does not wish to accept the Prize.
- 16. The Prize Draw winners agree to comply with the conditions of entry applicable at Wembley Stadium, and shall ensure that those attending with them do so. Contestants who are rude, abusive or deemed otherwise unsuitable by The FA may be excluded from the Prize Draw or required to leave any ground or stadium.
- 17. No winner can be subject to any Football Banning Order or equivalent court order and/or criminal conviction which restricts their ability to attend matches and/or makes them unsuitable to accept the prize. Any winner subject to such an order or conviction at the time of the Match will not be able to receive the prize and will be treated as having been disqualified from the Prize Draw. Such decision shall be at the sole discretion of The FA and will be final.

We will use the information that entrants provide to process the Prize Draw and we may publish the name and town of residence of the Winner or Runners-Up on The FA website and we may require them to participate in publicity. The winner of any prize may be required for promotional activity by The FA. We may send entrants information from time to time about The FA Group and other related football matters and shall process your information in accordance with The FA's <a href="Privacy Policy">Privacy Policy</a> which you are deemed to accept when entering the Prize Draw.

The FA reserves the right at its absolute discretion to disqualify any entry which it considers does not comply with these Terms and Conditions or any participant who it reasonably believes has interfered with the fair running of this Prize Draw, including providing false or misleading information.

- 21. No correspondence will be entered into in respect of this Prize Draw except with the prize winners.
